This Exhibitor Application and Payment is based upon acceptance by the Pool & Hot Tub Council of Canada. Once accepted, this Application becomes a Contract, subject to the cancellation and other policies detailed on page (3) of this contract.

1. **CONTRACT:** Submission of this application, when accepted by Show Management, constitutes a binding contract between the Exhibitor and the Pool & Hot Tub Council of Canada (PHTCC). Contract includes this document, the floor plan (subject to modification), Exhibitor Rules & Regulations, and the online Exhibitor Manual.
2. **LICENSE & TERM:** This contract grants permission to occupy allotted exhibit space from: Move-in: November 30 - December 1, 2026; Show days: December 2-3, 2026; Move-out: Must be fully completed by 6:00 p.m. on December 3, 2026
3. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS (UPDATED):** The Exhibitor must obtain and maintain Commercial General Liability (CGL) insurance of not less than CAD \$2,000,000 per occurrence, covering bodily injury, property damage, and personal injury. The policy must name the following as Additional Insured: Pool & Hot Tub Council of Canada; Canadian Pool & Spa Conference & Expo; Niagara Falls Convention Centre Proof of insurance must be submitted prior to move-in. Exhibitors will not be granted access to the show floor without providing compliant documentation. If you do not provide coverage, refunds will not apply.
4. **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS & VENUE REGULATIONS:** Exhibitor agrees to comply with: All federal, provincial, and municipal laws; Niagara Falls Convention Centre (NFCC) building rules; Fire, health, and safety regulations; Ontario Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) requirements; Show Management directives Non-compliance may result in removal from the event without refund.
5. **QUALIFICATIONS TO EXHIBIT:** Exhibitors must be manufacturers, distributors, importers, or companies aligned with the pool, spa, and backyard living industries. Show Management reserves the right to reject or remove any exhibit not aligned with the character of the show.
6. **LOCATION & RELOCATION OF EXHIBIT:** Show Management reserves the right to alter or reassign booth locations as necessary for the proper functioning of the show.
7. **SUB-LEASING & CO-EXHIBITORS:** Exhibitor may not sub-license or share booth space without written approval from Show Management. All co-exhibitors must submit a full application and comply with all terms.
8. **FAILURE TO OCCUPY SPACE:** All Exhibitors must complete move-in and occupy their assigned booth space by December 1, 2026, unless prior written approval is granted by Show Management. Any Exhibitor failing to occupy its booth space by 8:30 a.m. on December 2, 2026, may have the space reassigned or repurposed by Show Management without refund or compensation.
9. **NON-DELIVERY OF BUILDING:** PHTCC is not liable for failure to provide exhibit space if the venue becomes unavailable due to fire, natural disaster, labour dispute, government order, or any cause beyond Management's control.
10. **DAMAGES:** Exhibitor is responsible for all damages to venue property, equipment, or furnishings caused by Exhibitor, its employees, contractors, or agents.
11. **PAYMENTS & REFUNDS (UPDATED):** Applications must include at least 50% deposit to reserve space. Deposit must be received in full within 30 days of contract being signed. Full payment is due October 1, 2026. Cancellations received before October 1, 2026 → 50% refund. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received on or after October 1, 2026. Exhibitors submitting applications after August 1 must pay in full.
12. **FORCE MAJEURE (CLARIFIED):** If the exhibition is postponed or cancelled due to circumstances beyond the parties' control:
 - Parties agree to reschedule when feasible.
 - If cancellation is unavoidable, Exhibitor will receive a refund limited to fees paid to PHTCC for exhibit space only.
 - PHTCC is not responsible for ancillary costs (travel, shipping, accommodations, etc.).
 - If the show is terminated mid-event, refunds will be prorated.
13. **USE OF SPACE & DISPLAY RESTRICTIONS:** Exhibits must remain within the allotted footprint. Loud, hazardous, or disruptive displays may be restricted. Show Management may require modifications or removal at Exhibitor's expense.
14. **PROHIBITED ITEMS & BEHAVIOUR (NEW):** The following are not permitted without written authorization, violation may result in booth removal without refund:
 - Open flames, propane, or heating devices.
 - Alcohol service within booths
 - Hazardous chemicals
 - Excessive amplified sound
 - Animals (except service animals)
 - Cannabis promotion (per Ontario law)
 - Harassment or unsafe behaviour
15. **PHOTO & VIDEO RELEASE (NEW):** Exhibitor grants PHTCC the right to photograph, film, and otherwise record its exhibit and to use these images in marketing and promotional materials without compensation.
16. **INDEMNIFICATION (NEW & CRITICAL):** Exhibitor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless PHTCC, the Canadian Pool & Spa Conference & Expo, NFCC, and their officers, directors, employees, and agents from all claims, liabilities, damages, costs, and expenses arising out of Exhibitor's participation, products, actions, or omissions.
17. **EXHIBITOR MANUAL:** All operational rules, booth guidelines, height limits, shipping instructions, and service order forms will be provided in the online Exhibitor Manual. These rules form part of this contract.
18. **AMENDMENTS:** Show Management may revise rules as necessary for the safe and effective operation of the show. All decisions are final.
